**Preschool programs are designed to nurture your child and prepare your child for kindergarten**

Children are provided with hands-on learning opportunities in language, literacy, math, science, art, music, health and well-being, social, emotional and physical development.

Children work on developing their school-readiness skills through interactions with peers, exploration, creativity, and experimentation. Our preschool programs follow the Minnesota Early Childhood Indicators of Progress.

# Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE)

## The Perfect Combination of Preschool & Parent Education

### For parents and children 3 to 5 years old

ECFE Preschool offers a high quality early education experience for children two to three days per week. Preschool children participate in a curriculum developed from the Minnesota Early Childhood Indicators of Progress. One day per week, parents meet with a licensed parent educator to build strategies and skills to support their child's learning and development.

Children must be the indicated age by September 1, 2019. Childcare is available for siblings 3 months through 5 years old while the parent and preschooler are in class. Registration is required to ensure that we have enough staff working to meet state guidelines. Children under 3 months are welcome to attend class with their parent.

## Early Childhood Screening

All children in Minnesota are required to complete an Early Childhood Screening to determine if they need additional support or services to prepare them for kindergarten.

We recommend that children be screened when they are **3 years old**. This helps ensure that all young children are well equipped for learning, and that families are aware of resources in the school and community.

Early Childhood Screening is a free and simple check of your child's vision, hearing, height, weight and development, as well as a review of immunizations.

The screening tools are designed to provide a snapshot of your child's motor, thinking, speech and language skills. This is not an IQ test, achievement test or comprehensive eye exam. The results are based on your child's age at the time of the screening.

Appointments are available Monday, through Friday and take about an hour. Call 763-504-4180 for an appointment.

Early Childhood Screening is a requirement for most of our early childhood programs.



# Early Adventures

## Full Day Care with Preschool Component

### For children 4 years old

Early Adventures is the full-day care with preschool component of Robbinsdale Area Schools. By combining high quality childcare with the district's preschool curriculum, this program offers an opportunity for students to prepare for Kindergarten in a safe, nurturing setting with adults who are especially trained to work with preschool students.

Early Adventures is open to any student who is eligible for Kindergarten the following school year. All students must be toilet trained before beginning the program. Students who have completed Early Adventures are guaranteed registration in Summer Adventure Club.

## Family Education

### For parents and children 33 months to 5 years old

The Family Literacy program provides opportunities for parents and their children, ages 33 months-5 years, to attend school together.

Parents work on GED, basic skills, English language or high school diploma in addition to attending parenting classes.

Children attend preschool to prepare them for kindergarten.

Family Literacy meets Monday-Thursday, 9 am - 2 pm.
