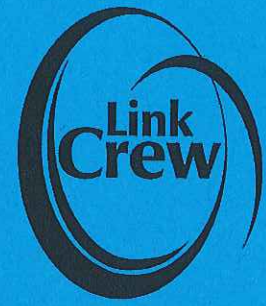




Freshman Parent Letter
