Students who want a partial refund for their cap, gown and tassel **must return these items to their ready room advisor after the ceremony, no exception.** Refunds can be picked up the following week, Monday, June 10 through Thursday, June 13 from the bookkeeper, 7:00 a.m. to Noon. Refunds will be given for the following items: Cap \$6, Gown \$11, and Tassel \$8. There is no refund for stoles. **Refunds are not mailed and will not be available after June 13.**

Again, we want to emphasize that the only individuals allowed in the building before, during, or after the commencement ceremony are student graduates, staff members, and senior party chaperones.

Once graduates are at the senior party, graduates will be there all night unless you have a pass from Ms. Patti Weldon, Activities Director, to leave for an athletic competition. Ms. Weldon will issue those passes. You will need to see her if this applies to you.

This will be the last time you are together with your classmates – so enjoy your senior party!

Senior Party - All seniors are invited to attend the All-Night Senior Party immediately following graduation. Prior registration and payment is required and can be completed at school or on-line at ahsseniortparty.net. See enclosed information sheet.

Cap/Gown/Tassel/Stole/Honor Cords and Medals – Cap/gown/tassel/stole will be distributed between 10:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 16 and Thursday, May 23 in the auditorium foyer to seniors who are cleared for graduation. Seniors must be current in course work, have no outstanding fines or equipment fees, and must turn in their dress and behavior contract (included in this mailing) in order to be cleared to obtain their cap/gown/tassel/stole and, if eligible, honor cord. Honor cords will be awarded to students who have achieved highest honors (1%), high honors (10%) or honors (top 20%) at the completion of the first semester (January 18, 2019). Honor medals with a blue ribbon (Highest Honors) or a red ribbon (High Honors) are awarded at the graduation rehearsal. **Parents are welcome to attend the rehearsal on Thursday morning, June 6. The rehearsal begins promptly at 8:45 a.m.**

Refunds will be available for cap, gown, and tassel (**not stole**). Tassels are often kept as souvenirs so please be sure you intend to turn it in as it cannot be returned later. Students must turn in any or all of these items **IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE CEREMONY** to their “ready room” advisor to get credit and be eligible for a refund. Refunds will be available for **PICK UP** from our bookkeeper from Monday, June 10 to Thursday, June 13 from 7 a.m. to noon. Refunds **ARE NOT MAILED** and **will not be available after June 13.** If you wish to receive a refund for these items the amount of refund will be:

Cap: \$ 6.00

Gown: \$ 11.00

Tassel: \$ 8.00

Once again, only items returned IMMEDIATELY following the commencement ceremony will be eligible for a refund.

It is our intention that all seniors will be able to complete the requirements for their diploma on time and fulfill all responsibilities in a timely manner. Seniors, remember that attendance is required through senior finals on Friday, May 31, and that there is **no** senior skip day. Parents, I know you will continue to encourage your student to keep on target for graduation, June 6, 2019.
